Our distinctive features include: a focus on quality teaching through teachers with the highest academic degrees and teacher training and support, large number of need-based scholarships, strong support for job placement and entrepreneurship initiatives, constant interaction with companies, government and civil society institutions and diverse international exchanges with more than 200 universities from all over the world.		
HISTORICAL SNAPSHOT	Universidad ORT Uruguay is a member of World ORT, a non-governmental, non-profit Jewish educational organization founded in Saint Petersburg, Russia, in 1880. Established in Montevideo as a technical school in 1942, ORT was formally recognized as a University by the Uruguayan government in 1996. At present, it is one of the largest non-governmental universities in Uruguay.

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## **STUDY AREAS &** Architecture, Interior Design, Engineering (Electronics, Telecommunications, Electrical, Software), **DEGREES** Biotechnology, Management, Accounting, Economics, International Studies, Design (Fashion, Graphics, Industrial, Multimedia), Animation and Videogames, Art and Technology, Communication (Audiovisual Production, Journalism, Advertising, Corporate), and Education. Universidad ORT Uruguay offers 55 undergraduate and postgraduate degrees, 22 vocational degrees, 100+ professional development courses and programmes. Production, communication, and transfer of knowledge are instrumental to the quality of ORT's **RESEARCH** education and contribute to better understanding of today's global problems. Through 12 research groups, its own Internal Research Fund created in 2005, and numerous national and international grants received, Universidad ORT Uruguay contributes to the generation of basic and applied knowledge, often through joint projects with industry. Involvement of undergraduates in research is pursued through capstone projects addressing actual needs of industry and research assistantships. Academic staff includes over 180 Ph.D. or Doctorate degrees holders. **INNOVATION &** ORT strives to integrate innovation and the entrepreneurial spirit throughout its academic activities. In **ENTREPRENEURSHIP** 2001 it launched the first business incubator for technological start-ups in the country, Ingenio, in partnership with the National Technology Laboratory and initial support from the Inter-American Development Bank. The Centre for Innovation & Entrepreneurship (CIE) trains and supports entrepreneurs to materialize their projects. Since its establishment in 2007, the CIE has supported the creation of 131 established start-ups, many of which have won awards and conquered international markets. INTERNATIONALIZATION We pursue internationalization as a means to enhance the quality of teaching, research and community outreach. Our international engagement includes over 215 international agreements with academic institutions in 34 countries; collaborative teaching and research; participation in international networks, projects, and programs; promotion of student and staff mobility. Visiting Scholars programs; Spanish language programs; and international short programs in English. Universidad ORT Uruguay is a member of major international associations such as the International Association of Universities (IAU) and the Unión de Universidades de América Latina (UDUAL). STUDENT MOBILITY Universidad ORT Uruguay promotes student internationalization through mobility programs (i.e. Erasmus+, Mercosur's MARCA and PMM), bilateral student exchange agreements with partner universities, and free mobility. It offers incoming students a Spanish language course and a variety of English-taught courses. The Student Exchange Office was established in 2004 to manage and support incoming and outgoing students. It implements bilateral student exchange agreements with over 125 higher institutions worldwide and regularly manages around 250 incoming and outgoing students each year. **AWARDS &** Universidad ORT Uruguay's degrees are officially recognized by the Uruguayan Ministry of Education as **RECOGNITIONS** mandated by national law. Relevant degrees are also internationally accredited by the MERCOSUR accreditation system which includes Argentina, Brazil, Bolivia, Chile, Colombia, Paraguay, and Uruguay (Mercosur accredited degrees include Electronics Engineering and Architecture). Positions in QS Rankings: 471 (2022 Global), 85 (2022 Latin America), 501+ (2022 Graduate Employability). Positions in THE Rankings: 101-125 (2021 Latin America), 401-600 (2021 Impact Rankings). Universidad ORT Uruguay is the only Uruguayan university ranked by THE in its Latin American ranking. ORT's MBA program is internationally accredited by the Association of MBAs (AMBA), among other international distinctions. Since 1995, it has been the only MBA in the country classified among the 35 best in Latin America by the América Economía's annual ranking (#23 Ranking 2021). The ORT's School of Administration & Social Sciences (Business School) has led the modernization of management education in the country. Two campuses with near 26,000 sq. meters of facilities built. **FACILITIES & TECHNOLOGICAL** Teaching and research laboratories, 110+ classrooms equipped for simultaneous remote and in-person **RESOURCES** teaching, Prototyping Lab, 3D Printing, design laboratories, project rooms, fully-equipped videoconferencing rooms, professional audiovisual production complex, auditoriums and seminar rooms equipped with multimedia technology, two libraries and a virtual library, advanced data network with over 1,800 computers connected to the Internet (Internet 2, RedCLARA) with high-capacity optic fibre links, and full Wi-Fi coverage.



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
